



APELDOORN STATION SQUARE

The station square consists of a shell-shaped area. Sand colored paving of yellow Portuguese granite and an abundance of pine trees are a direct reference to the landscape of the region. Line drains, tree grits and lighting poles are seamlessly integrated in a craquelure-style pattern. The highlight of the site is a glass wall that covers the level difference to the pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the railway. To turn this rather dark and north-facing wall into an attractive and interesting feature it was illuminated by over a million LED-lights. This glass wall can be used to simulate a sand storm – a movement that corresponds with the dynamics of the settings. A series of elements, matching the polygon craquelure pattern, further enlivens the space.
